## **Top 14 Plan Review Errors For Interior Projects**

- 1 Outdated and wrong codes referenced: Reference IBC and 120-3-3 Codes Reference Guide (hierarchy table)
- 2 Occupant load and exit capacity: Is stair capacity sufficient for occupant load of entire floor? Reference NFPA 101: 7.3.1 & 7.3.3
- 3 Clear floor space at accessible toilet room: New space requirements. Reference 120-3-20 604.3 (2012 ADAAG)
- 4 Remoteness of exit separation: New Construction vs Existing. Reference NFPA 101: 7.5.1.5.2 and 7.3.1.3.5
- 5 Elevator Lobby Locking: Access to a single exit must be maintained under <u>all</u> conditions. *Reference NFPA 101: 7.2.1.6*
- 6 No listings shown for rated walls: No listed assemblies shown. Reference UL Directory or other approved source
- 7 Common path of travel is incorrect: Two paths converge and shall be "remotely located." Reference NFPA 101: 7.5.1.3.1
- 8 Unrated finishes used: Wood, plastics and textiles on walls and ceilings, plastics. Reference NFPA 101: 10.2
- 9 Improper vertical openings: Applicable NFPA 101 section not referenced. *Reference NFPA 101: 8.6*
- 10 Portable fire extinguishers not provided: Required locations? Refence IFC 906.1
- 11 Enclosures: Exit enclosures, horizontal exits, incidental use areas and mixed occupancy separations. Reference NFPA 101: 8.6
- **12** Door swings: Must swing in direction of means of egress. *NFPA 101: 7.2.1.4.2*
- 13 Fire alarm strobes not included: Ommitted in large or assembly buildings w/ load over 300. Reference NFPA 12.3.4.1 & 28.3.4.1
- 14 Upgrade thresholds to new construction not recognized: IBC Amdts, NFPA 101 and ADAAG. Designer must consult AHJ
