## SUSTAINABLE GROWTH & ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

### STORMWATER

- 57 identified projects: Three are under design, six are in contract development, four in easement acquisition, two in technical review, 22 in scope development, and the remaining pending final invoice or inspection.
- Nine new stormwater work requests received.
- 5280 North Powers Ferry (Design and Construction) – Phase I includes removing pipes from stream and restoring stream bank. Construction is substantially complete. Change Order approved for additional work to stabilize the streambank. Work will be performed next week, weather permitting. Additional streambank restoration task started March 29 and is ongoing.
- 70 Seville Chase (Construction) – Pipes and structures will be lined or replaced. Utility coordination underway with Fulton County to replace degraded sewer line in conjunction with construction. Construction progressing as planned. A change order is under review.
- 5758 Riverside Drive (Pre-Construction) – The project will correct a persistent roadway flooding problem and stabilize the road shoulder. Construction progressing as planned. All stormwater structures installed and functioning per design. Final stabilization is ongoing and only groundcover planting remains to be installed.
- 435 Pine Forest Road – Potential federal funding opportunities for hazard mitigation assistance grants are under investigation. Phase II plan development completed. Right of Entry to a private property received. Construction scheduled to begin Thursday April 1.
- 4878 Long Island Drive (Pre-construction) – Project consultant prepared plans to replace a deteriorating end wall along Long Island Drive just outside the right of way. Discussion with impacted homeowners continues. Purchase Order issued. A pre-construction meeting will be scheduled for early next week.
- 821 Tanglewood/4825 Jett Road (Pre-construction) – A pipe will be replaced under the road. Construction plans approved. Easement offer packages emailed to affected property owners. Working remaining easements. Approved minor adjustments to the plans due to field conditions. Construction progressing. A change order is under review due to unexpected field conditions.
- 7275 Twin Branch Road – Stormwater system has failed and must be replaced. The project is in condition review and concept phase. Concept level designs completed. A draft easement document sent to affected property owner for signature. Plans ready for submittal for permit. Awaiting easement donation. Appraisal report submitted for review.
- 5690 Lake Forrest Drive – A depressed area in front yard is under investigation. Soil testing/sampling completed. Written report including recommendations received. Coordination with the property owner is underway. Consultant selected for design phase services.
- 7236 Thornhill Lane – Existing Conditions Assessment Study kicked off and ground run survey completed. Study is progressing. Received cost proposal for additional study.
- 201 Mt. Vernon Road – Existing failed cross drains under Mt. Vernon Road are scheduled to be replaced at two locations. The contractor has been selected and work authorized. Work at area one is under way. Construction is nearly completed.
- 980 Crest Valley Road – The design project will correct streambank erosion near a pipe end. A headwall will be designed and other repairs will be engineered. Conceptual plans were reviewed and approved. Construction documents received. Plans are under review.

## **RECREATION AND CULTURAL ENHANCEMENT**

### **CREATE SANDY SPRINGS**

- Executed events were the CMII Meeting and Coles College MBA Classes.
- Planning is underway with the Georgia Commission on the Holocaust for a virtual video filming in Byers Theater.
- Planning is underway for the upcoming Holy Innocence Prom in April.
- A tour of the Entertainment Lawn was given to our returning BMI client for the BMI Gospel Awards in June.
- New event inquiries and event safety plans for upcoming events including the Epstein Graduation, Elite Dance Spring Recital, Atlanta Ballet Spring Concert, and the returning Netflix Raising Dion Season 2 catering event.
- New event bookings were a B'nei Mitzvah in May, the Drake House Fashion Show in April, Caffeine & Exotics in October, a memorial celebration event in August, and a corporate meeting for our client with Small Business Matters for May. Rental revenue from these events will be \$11,560.
- All Farmers Market vendors have been converted to Manage my Market payment registration system. We expect to have the 41 vendors with 16 new vendors for the opening on April 17.
- Concerts by the Springs and City Green Live free tickets became available and sold out within an hour of release. Table sales for Concerts by the Springs have slowed but most have been claimed by previous table patrons.
- The History Museum Curator is working with the communication manager at Riverwood High School, who requested assistance on a display they are creating for their 50th anniversary.
- The Food and Beverage Team completed their training manuals for catering and concessions processes.

## **RECREATION AND PARKS**

### **PROJECTS**

- The Hammond Park Erosion Control Project: The second stage of the wall has been poured with forms removed. Manholes around the restroom and walkway as well as a trench drain on the turf field are proposed as RFI's to Pond. Grading for the wall above the gym will commence this week. The pipe intended as a conduit for Georgia Power's severed lines feeding the tennis court has been delivered.
- Hammond Turf Field Replacement: The field goal areas were excavated in advance of sod this week. Goals, netting, and site furnishings selected with purchasing agreement proposed to procurement team.
- Morgan Falls Athletic Complex: Concrete has been cut in preparation of the new pipe and drains to facilitate improved drainage off the field behind Field 1 bleacher.
- Allen Road Park Project: materials were planted. The rain garden feature will be pumped dry this week in preparation of the work on it next week.

- Ison Springs IGA Improvements Project is awaiting shade structure installation. Remaining project funds, for installation of a pavilion at the basketball court area.
- Presented Crooked Creek Park and Trail conditions to state Metropolitan River Protection Act expert for consideration of impervious surface needs to overcome flooding on the trail.
- The River Shore Meadows Park design was revised and the submittal package was sent to Georgia Emergency Management Agency for review prior to Federal Emergency Management Agency. The Plans to be reviewed again by Community Development on March 31.

#### SUSTAINABILITY

- The Sustainability Survey conducted by GA Tech is closing on April 1. Results to date: 200 responses from the community at large, and 40 responses from small businesses.
- Sustainability Staff participated in regularly scheduled workgroup meetings with the Southeast Sustainability Directors Network.
- Sustainability Staff is reviewing the project scope for the Nancy Creek improvements at Windsor Meadows Park (319 Grant).

#### LANDSCAPE

- Staff worked on landscape plan for William Payne House with City partner Garden Club.
- Staff worked on landscape design and installation plan for Ison Springs Elementary project.
- Staff worked on Fall tree plantings in coordination with contract partner Trees Atlanta.

#### MAINTENANCE

- Park staff evaluated Hammond Gym's new leaks in the roof. Scheduled a meeting with contractor this week.
- Park staff performed weekly inspection for trash on the trails at Crooked Creek and Spaulding trail.
- Park staff tested the outdoor park water fountains and noted any maintenance issues.
- Removed a sign post from Allen Rd.
- Overlook Park dock and ramp closed due displaced dock issue. Contractor has been scheduled to repair.
- Addressed erosion control issue to divert water from pooling onto the playground at Ridgeview Park.

## PROGRAMMING

- Program staff had to cancel Plant a Seed program due to thunderstorms in the area.
- Program staff prepared part time staff and department partner organization Optimist club members for necessary tasks during the event.
- Program staff promoted Sandy Springs Gymnastics Spring Break camp for gymnastics program contractor.
- Program staff worked on Georgia certification of Advance Training for Environmental Education in order to continue to offer environmental education programming

## TRANSPORTATION ACCESSIBILITY & COMMUNITY APPEARANCE

### TSPLOST PROGRAM

- TS-103 Spalding/Dalrymple/Trowbridge Intersection Improvement Project: Guardrail installation complete. Wall cladding work underway. Final grading, sidewalks and grassing ongoing. Coordination to transfer power to the new signals underway. Paving will occur week of April 5th depending on weather.
- TS-105 Roswell Road at Grogan's Ferry Road Intersection Improvement: Notice to Proceed was issued on March 29, 2021.
- TS-106 Northside Drive at Riverview/Old Powers Ferry: Right of way acquisition underway. Final plans under review. Prequalification package for construction being compiled.
- TS-107 ATMS 4 – SCOOT Implementation in the Perimeter Area: All fieldwork is complete. Equipment detection validation and system tuning underway. Final walk-through scheduled for April 7, 2021.
- TS-108 Roswell Road at Dalrymple Road: Final plans received from the design consultant and in review. Right of way acquisition is underway. Prequalification package for construction being compiled.
- TS-111 Spalding Drive at Pitts Road: Right-of-way acquisition efforts are beginning. Right of way staking completed.
- TS-166 Spalding Drive Widening Project - Winters Chapel Road to Holcomb Bridge Road: Georgia Power Company installed new poles to relocate facilities. The construction contractor (administered by Gwinnett County) is advancing new roadway and bridge construction with bridge foundation and deck work currently underway.
- TS-167 Brandon Mill Sidewalk from Marsh Creek to Lost Forest: Due to several complications, we have stopped work and are evaluating options to complete this project. The City must follow legal contract and procurement policies. As we determine the method of moving forward, we will provide updates on the revised timetable and activity schedule. The site has been temporarily secured pending resolution. Additional site survey work is underway.
- TS-168 Dalrymple Road Sidewalk (Princeton Way to Duncourtney Dr.): This segment will provide sidewalk on at least one side of the road along Dalrymple from Roswell Road to Brandon Mill Road. Design is underway. Construction planned to begin mid-2021.
- TS-169 Dunwoody Club Drive Sidewalk from Spalding Drive to Fenimore Circle: Design work, advance utility relocations and right of way acquisition are underway. Construction planned to begin June 2021.

- TS-170 Interstate North Parkway Multi-use Path (Northside Drive to the Chattahoochee River Bridge): Right of way acquisition is near completion. Construction is planned to begin early Summer 2021.
- TS-171 Roberts Drive Sidewalk from Northridge Road to Davis Academy: Advance clearing and utility relocation with ongoing lane closures has started. Construction is underway.
- TS-172 Brandon Mill Road Sidewalk (Lost Forrest Drive to Brandon Ridge Drive): This sidewalk segment will complete a sidewalk network connecting the length of Brandon Mill Road from Dalrymple Road to Abernathy. Design is underway. Construction planned to begin late 2021.
- TS-191 Mt. Vernon at Johnson Ferry Improvements: Staff is coordinating with Georgia Power to advance plans for the relocation of transmission poles at Mt. Vernon and Roswell Road and undergrounding of aerial utility services in the area from Roswell Road to Hilderbrand. Preparations underway for utility location borings on Johnson Ferry Road and Mt Vernon Hwy. Right of way acquisition efforts are also underway.
- TS-192 Mt. Vernon Highway Corridor Improvements: Development of Final Plans and Drainage Report is ongoing. Right of way acquisition efforts are also underway.

#### CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP)

- T-0019 Roswell Road Streetscapes (East Side - City Limit to I 285. West Side - City Limit to Long Island): This federally-funded, MARTA sponsored project is advancing with the design consultant now selected. Concept design work begins in the first quarter of 2021.
- T-0033-7 CDBG Sidewalks Roswell Road Streetscape from I-285 to Long Island: Sidewalk construction is near completion with work underway north of the intersection of West Belle Isle Drive and Roswell Road. Currently awaiting utility relocations to complete work and then install pedestrian scale street lighting.
  - Phase 2 of the project from Stewart Drive to I-285 is currently in right of way acquisition and utility coordination. Phase 2 construction is planned for late 2021.
- T-0035 Roswell Road Bicycle/Pedestrian Bridge over Chattahoochee River: This project is being delivered through cooperation with the City of Roswell and the Georgia Department of Transportation. The Atlanta Regional Commission recently approved sufficient funds required to construct the project.
- T-0043 Glenridge Drive @ Roswell Road Intersection Realignment: This construction project is administered by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). Traffic is now relocated to the new intersection alignment while construction continues on roadway and road shoulder improvements. GDOT is currently coordinating utility relocations to continue project construction.
- T-0058-1 Boylston Drive Streetscape and Hammond intersection realignment: This project will complete streetscape improvements between Hilderbrand Drive and Hammond Drive and realign the intersection at Hammond to improve traffic efficiency. Concept design is currently underway. Right-of-way acquisitions and utility coordination are scheduled to begin Fall 2021 and construction is anticipated to begin in 2022.
- T-0060 SR 400 Multi-Use Path: Geotechnical investigation borings are underway along the shoulder of GA400. Field work is expected to continue along GA400 and on the side streets east of the proposed Multi-Use Path throughout March and April. The Atlanta Regional

Commission granted \$688,000 in federal matching funds for right of way. The Georgia Department of Transportation is working on Right of Way Authorization.

- T-0064 Peachtree Dunwoody at Telford Roadway Improvements Project: This project provides safety enhancements along the road near the intersection. Right-of-way acquisitions and utility coordination are underway. Construction planned to begin by Summer 2021.
- T-0069 Peachtree Dunwoody at Windsor Parkway Intersection Project: This project provides safety and operational improvements at the existing intersection. Right-of-way acquisitions and utility coordination are underway. Construction planned for Summer 2021.
- CC-0010 Sandy Springs Circle Streetscape Hammond to Mt. Vernon Hwy: Utility relocation work continues in conjunction with the construction project. Storm drainage system installation is underway with work on major side slopes and retaining walls underway. Lane shifts and ongoing lane closures are in use along Sandy Springs Circle.
- T-0067 Mt. Vernon Highway/Dupree Intersection upgrade: The project will upgrade signal infrastructure to meet current standards and will include decorative poles and mast arms. Final Plans are in development and construction is planned for this year.

#### TRANSPORTATION/TRAFFIC

- The Emergency Vehicle Preemption project, T-0065 is operational. The Emergency Vehicle Preemption project has equipped 26 Fire Department units and 113 signalized intersections with the Glance preemptive technology. The Glance preemption system is a cloud-based service which processes routes for emergency vehicles and communicates wirelessly with the traffic cabinet to clear traffic ahead of the vehicle's arrival. The Phase 2 project is currently under construction. This deployment will bring 20 additional signals in Fire Districts 3 and 5 into the EVP Program this spring.
- The Transportation Department is at the midpoint on the Georgia Smart Communities project with the Georgia Institute of Technology. The City of Sandy Springs, in partnership with the City of Dunwoody, MARTA, and Georgia Tech researchers, submitted a proposal in June 2020 for a grant to "Streamline Suburban Transit" to improve the transit experience for existing and future riders. The project will leverage existing infrastructure to test transit signal priority (TSP) technology using bus location data published through an application program interface (API) instead of communicating with a unit on board the bus. The results of this study will inform how TSP could be implemented in the City in the future. The Georgia Smart grant was announced in early August, and Sandy Springs was awarded a grant of \$75,000 from the Atlanta Regional Commission to undertake the project. The City's match for the grant is \$18,750, for a total of \$93,750. The project will begin testing Transit Signal Priority operations in April.
- The Transportation Department is working with neighbors in Wyndham Hills, Whitner/Idlewood, Huntcliff, Glenridge-Hammond, and Glen Errol on traffic calming initiatives. The City's Adopted Traffic Calming policy is a neighbor-driven process to calm traffic on neighborhood streets. <http://www.sandyspringsga.gov/city-services/transportation-infrastructure/traffic-calming>
- The Traffic Department is continuing the engineering analysis and design project for short-range improvements and long-range alternatives to address ongoing safety concerns at the Roswell Road/SR 9 at Abernathy Road intersection.
- The Traffic Management Center is upgrading School Flashers and radar speed feedback signs (RSFS) at 12 locations for the following schools: Riverwood High School, Lake Forest Elementary, High Point Elementary, Hebrew Academy, and Ison Elementary. The project will

include installing communications equipment for remote access, programming, and monitoring. The project will be completed in early April.

- The Traffic Management Center is upgrading back-up power systems for 30 signalized intersections throughout the spring. There may be brief, intermittent signal outages (i.e., signal in flash or signal dark) during construction.
- The Transportation Department is soliciting for proposals for a North End Roadway Safety Analysis. The procurement opened on January 13 and closed on February 11.
- The Transportation Department is soliciting for proposals for an Access Management Study on Roswell Road. The procurement opened on February 17 and closed on March 19.
- The Traffic Department is undertaking a concept study at the Intersection of Mt. Vernon Highway and Long Island Drive under the Intersection Operations and Safety Program. Field survey work is underway in the vicinity of Mt. Vernon Highway and Long Island Drive and should be completed in early April.

- **T-3000 Pavement Maintenance:**
  - FY2020 Resurfacing underway.
  - FY2021 Resurfacing work began November 9, 2020.
  - FY2021 Pavement Condition Inspection awarded with inspection and report in review.
- **FY2020 and FY2021 RESURFACING SCHEDULE:** Please note that the resurfacing schedule is subject to change as weather interruptions may delay work activities. Paving is routinely conducted in three phases with patching, then milling the existing pavement and finally installing a new asphalt topping. The current paving schedule is also available on the City’s Road Work Advisory page.

### **OPERATIONS**

Responded to 253 calls: Four Fires, 77 EMS, 27 Service, 115 Good Intent, 23 False Alarms

- Units responded to reports of a structure fire in the 7500 block of Wildercliff Drive. Upon arrival, crewmembers saw smoke showing on the Alpha and Bravo side of the structure. Crews did a walk around and assigned fire attack with a 1 ¾" line. Fire was contained to courtyard pool area in wall.
- Units responded to reports of a structure Fire at Cedar Run. Upon arrival, crewmembers reported a working fire on a two-story apartment with fire and heavy smoke showing from the second floor Bravo/Charlie side. Sandy Springs Police were on scene evacuating residents. Crews knocked down the bulk of the fire using water from the deck gun on the Alpha side. Another truck arrived on scene, began stretching 200 feet of hose to a hydrant, and set up the ladder for aerial operations. Crewmembers advanced the hand line up the stairs. At this time, all crews withdrew from the building as conditions were rapidly deteriorating with fire extending throughout the roof and second floor. Storm like winds came out of nowhere and assisted in spreading the fire from the Alpha side to the Delta side. Personnel requested an investigator, Fire Corps, Red Cross and utilities to the scene.
