A separate Commercial <u>Accessory Structure Permit</u>, <u>Additions and Alterations Permit</u>, or <u>New Building Permit</u> will be required for all new structures or modifications to existing structures that enclose the pool.

This application includes any associated pool enclosures such as fences, walls, or gates. However, if the scope of the project includes any retaining walls, a separate Retaining Wall - Commercial Permit will be required.
