




Repurposing Northside Drive & New Northside Drive

The study considered two alternatives for the street network: (1) Converting the one-way streets to two-way traffic, and (2) Repurposing one travel lane for walking and bicycling. Based on multiple factors including transportation safety considerations, public/stakeholder sentiment, and construction cost, the second alternative is recommended.

Northside Drive: Existing Conditions THREE TRAVEL LANES



- 12-foot travel lanes
- 5-foot sidewalk on one side (with large gaps)
- No bicycle facilities

Northside Drive: Recommendation ALLOCATE SPACE FOR WALKING/BIKING


- 11 to 12-foot travel lanes
- 10 to 12-foot side path (for bicyclists and pedestrians)
- 6-foot sidewalk

The Alternative Provides:

- One-way pair traffic flow is preserved with reduced travel lanes to provide space for a new 10-foot side path on one side of the street
- Add 6-foot sidewalk on other side of street
- Two bridges over I-285: remove one travel lane to accommodate the side path (within existing bridge width)
- Add street lighting, upgrade traffic signals, enhance intersections, and implement wrong-way driving mitigation measures
- The alternative can be phased
