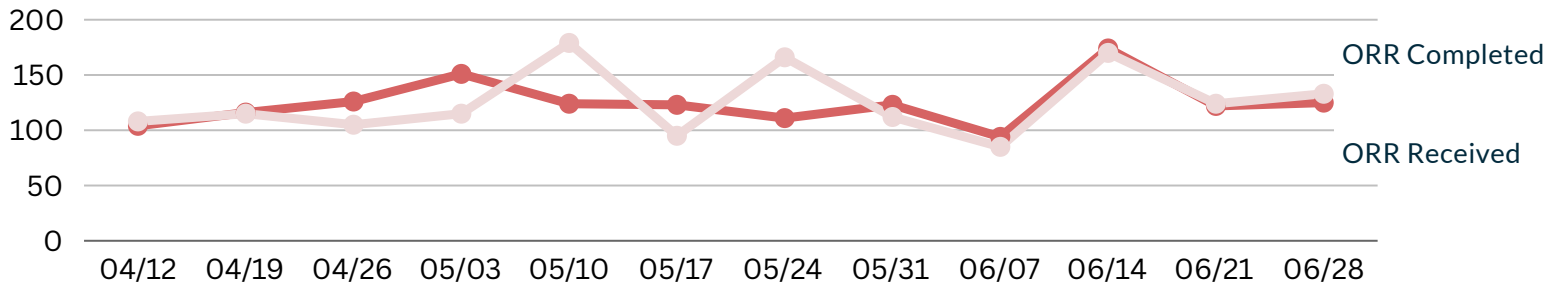

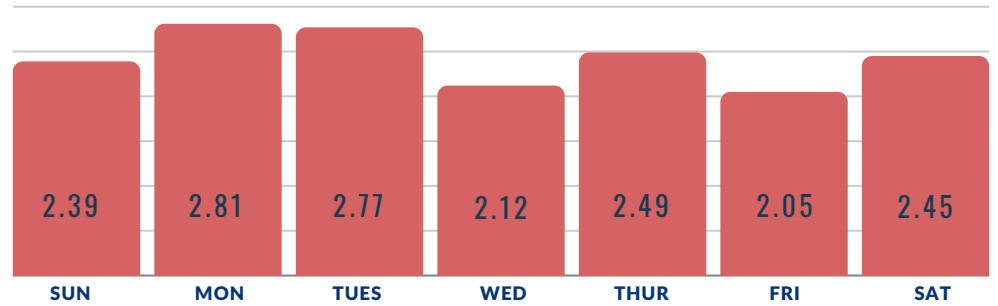

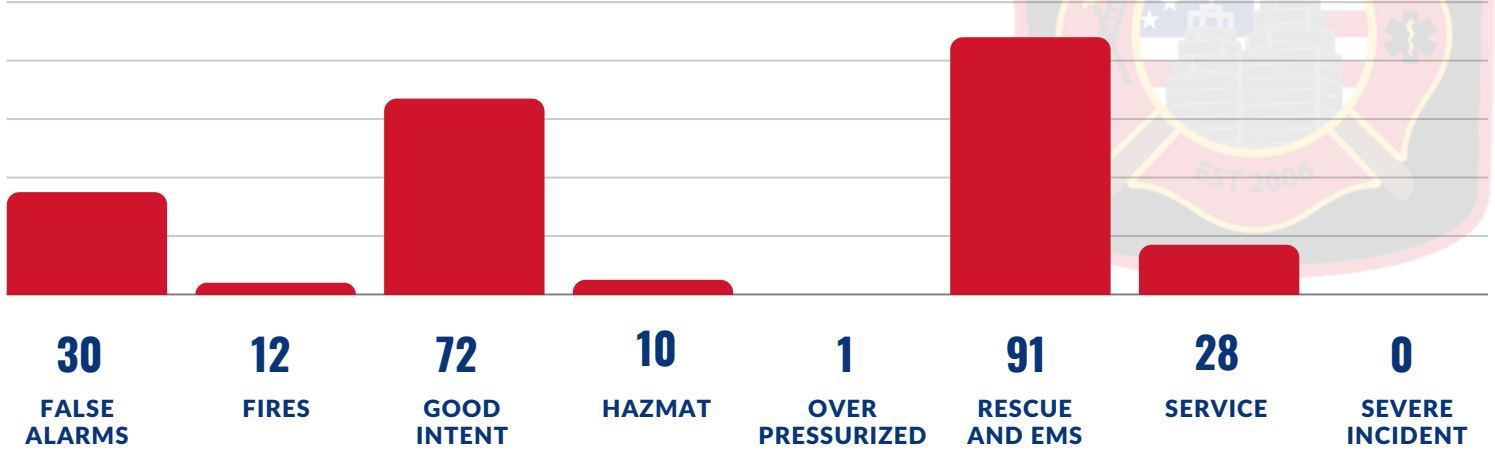

VOLUNTEER UNIT

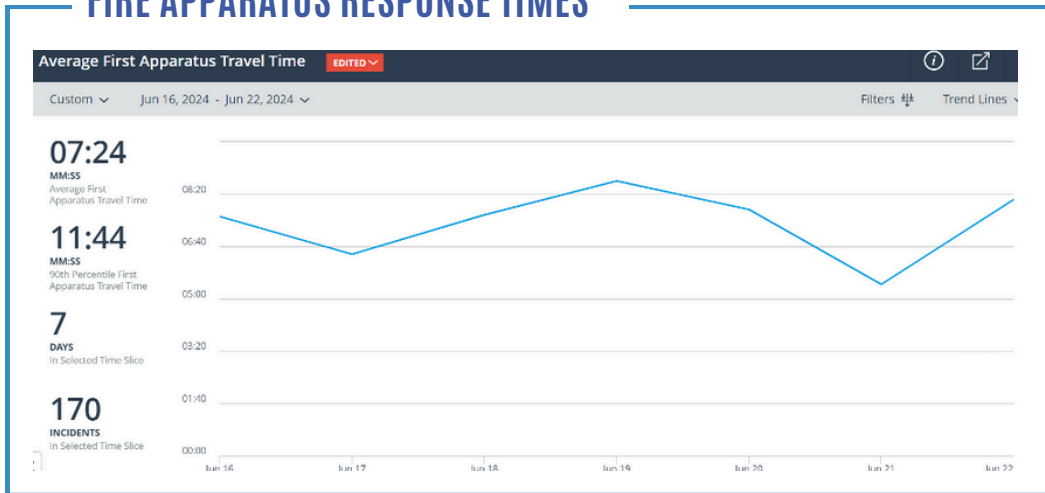

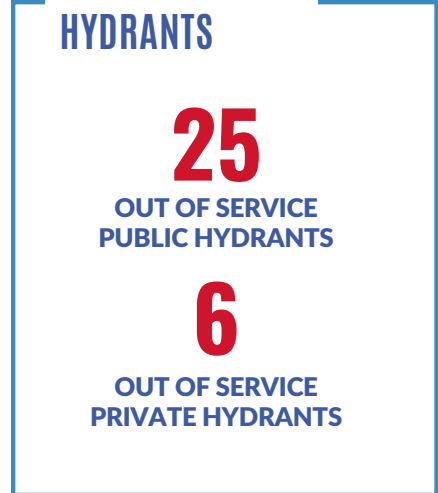

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

Fire units responded to the following reported incidents:

- Multiple vehicle fires in the driveway of single-family home in the 8900 block of River Run. Two vehicles and a privacy fence were heavily involved with the fire extended to a third vehicle. The fire was extinguished, and overhaul was performed. The Fire Marshal's Office was contacted for an investigation.
- An outside equipment fire at a multi-family structure with no flames visible from the exterior in the 700 block of Hammond Drive. Personnel were advised that a fire on the balcony was extinguished prior to arrival. There appeared to be burnt wiring from a small solar panel charging unit that was used to charge decorative lighting. Overhaul was performed and the area was cooled with multiple water cans.
- A two-car motor vehicle accident in the 400 block of River Valley Road. Personnel assisted AMR with patient care. AMR handled transport.
- A gas leak in the 500 N Harbor Drive. Personnel observed an odor of gas that was coming from the kitchen stove. Personnel found the leaking valve and was able to secure the gas line.

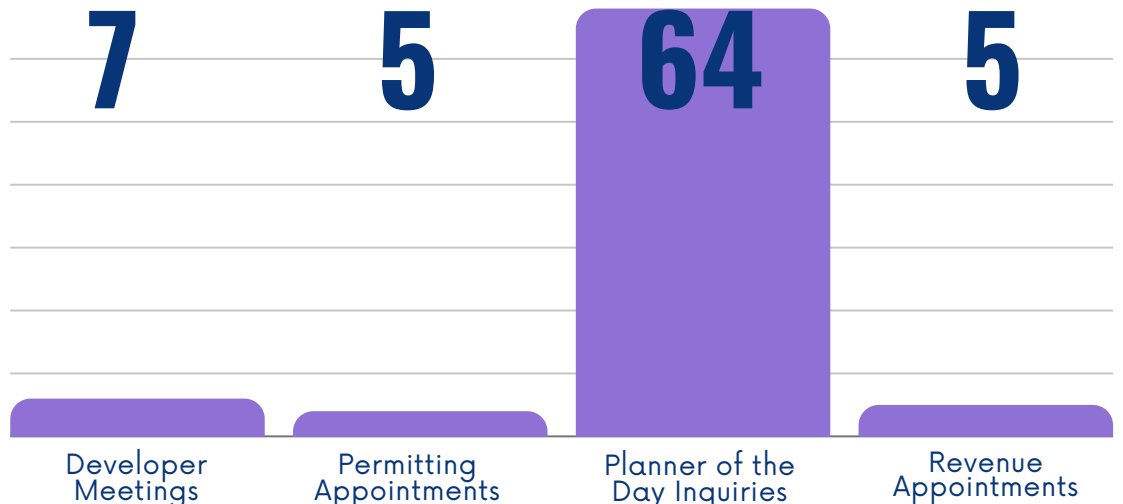

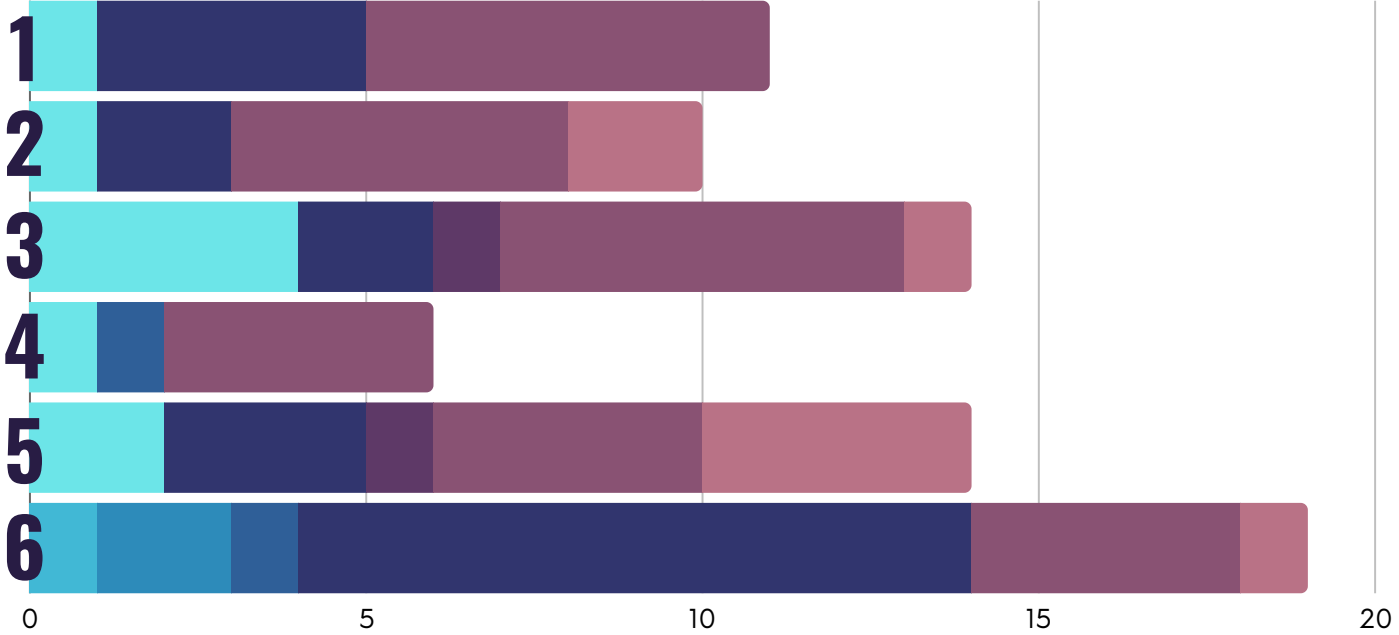

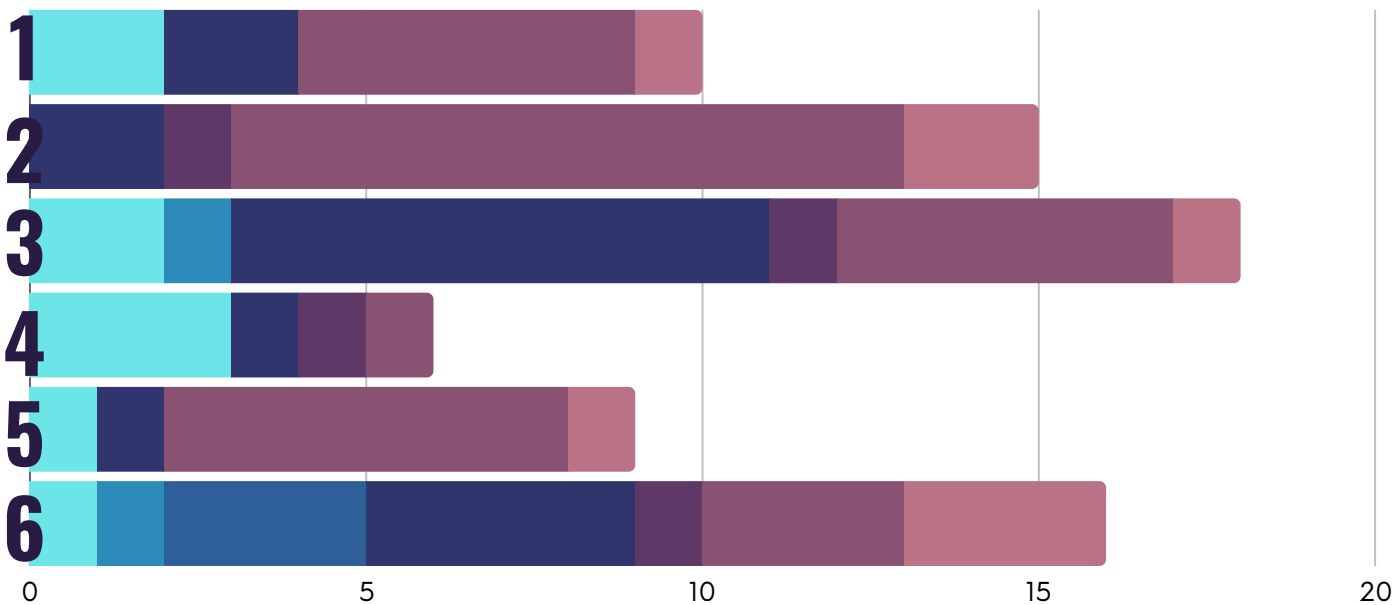

For existing or active permits

The permitting portal will be down for existing and active permits beginning on Friday, June 28, reopening on Monday, July 8. All online and in-person permitting transactions, including scheduling of inspections, Certificates of Occupancy or Completion, payments for permitting, and Plan Reviews will be unavailable during this time.

For new permits

Because new permit submittals will not require migration and mapping of new data, the OpenGov portal will be available to accept all new permit types beginning on Wednesday, July 3.

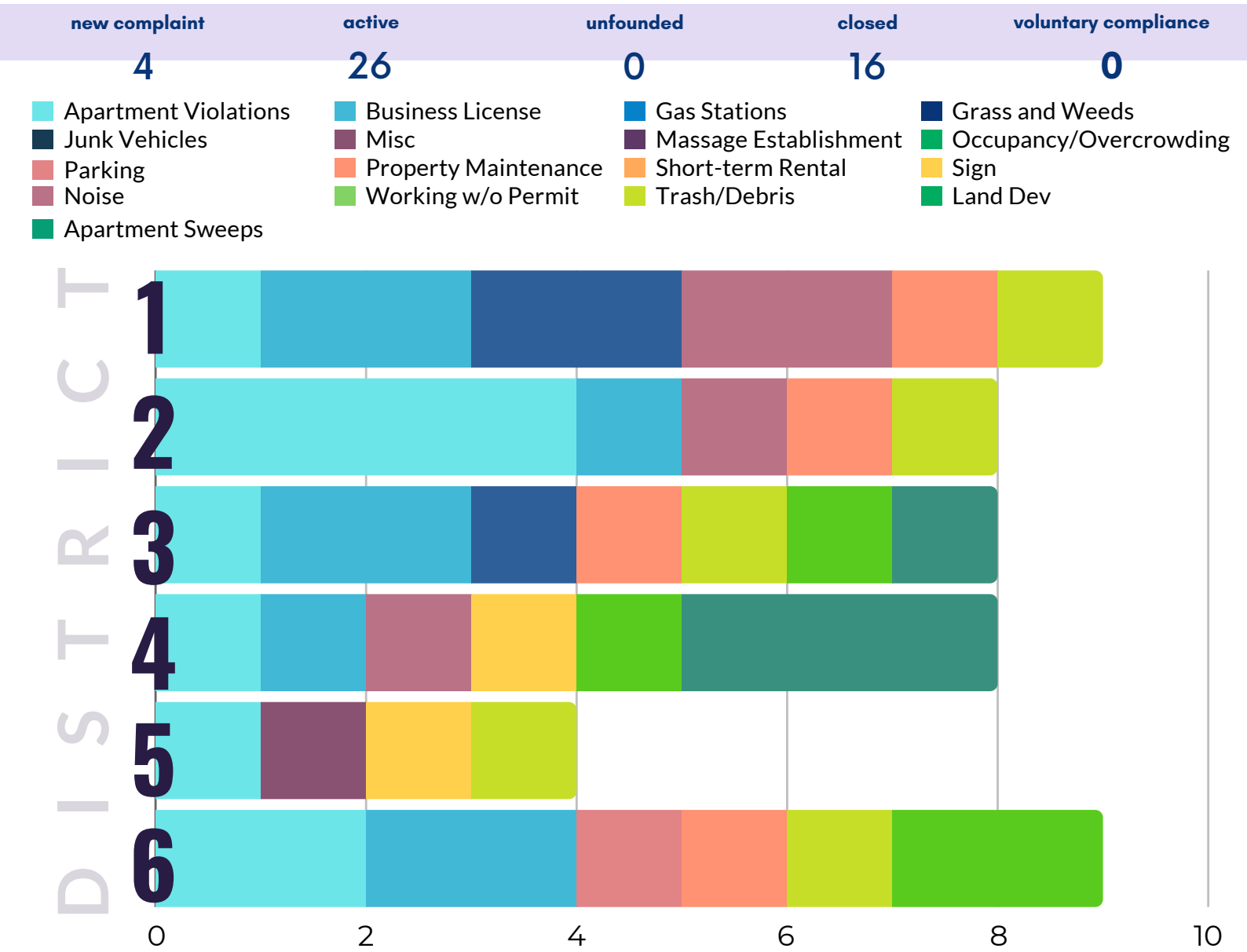
The Community Development office will still be open to handle inquiries, manually schedule inspections, conduct meetings, accept information regarding Planning and Zoning and Special Event Applications, and other matters. There will be no interruptions to Code Enforcement activities, inspections or investigations.

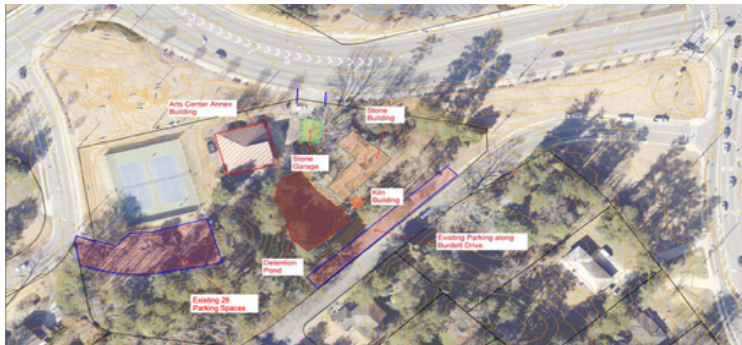

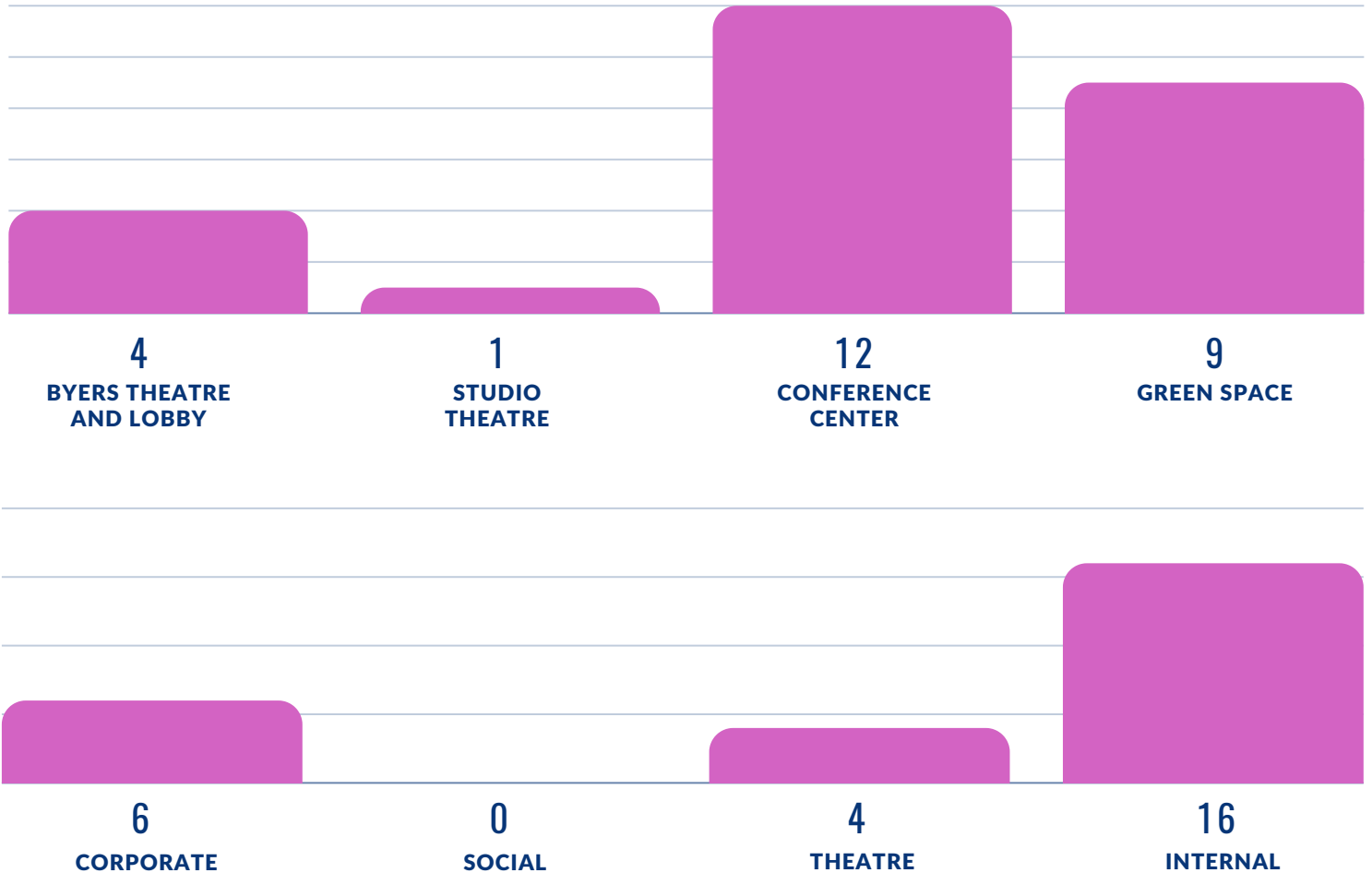

PROJECTS

ALLEN ROAD PARK

- Completed work associated with demolition and installation of replacement synthetic turf. Recent improvements at Allen Road have included the replacement of a foot bridge, replacement netting at the soccer pitch, and extensive fence replacement at the pitch. (Photos below).



MORGAN FALLS ATHLETIC COMPLEX IMPROVEMENTS

- A staggered closure of all fields is planned from July 1 through August 13 to renovate and level the grass turf. All but Field 2 and Field 5 will close July 1 to 23 for renovation. Fields 2 and 5 will close July 23 through August 13. Fields will be locked and signage posted.

SPRINGWAY TRAIL 2A

- Boardwalk pier and framing work has slowed due to rocky conditions while the contractor has been on land for some time, averaging approximately 10' per day over the past week. The boardwalk connection to Monterey Parkway and the end of new construction is very close, with a July 8th projection for completion of this phase. Trail signage installation has begun.

- Basketball camp was full with 23 campers at North Springs High School.



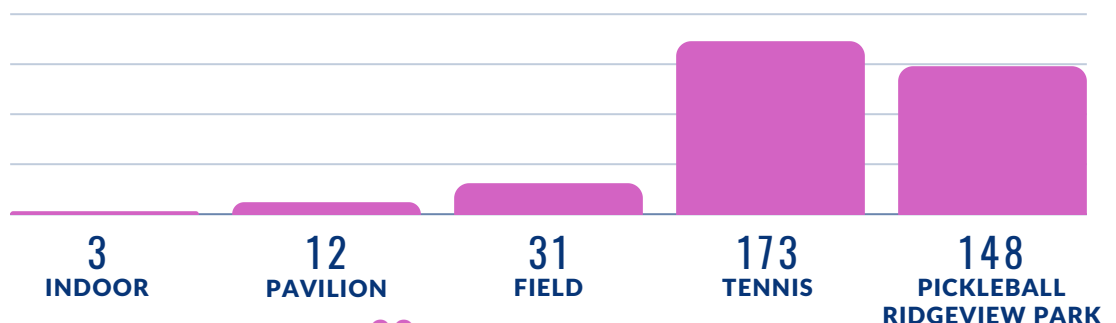

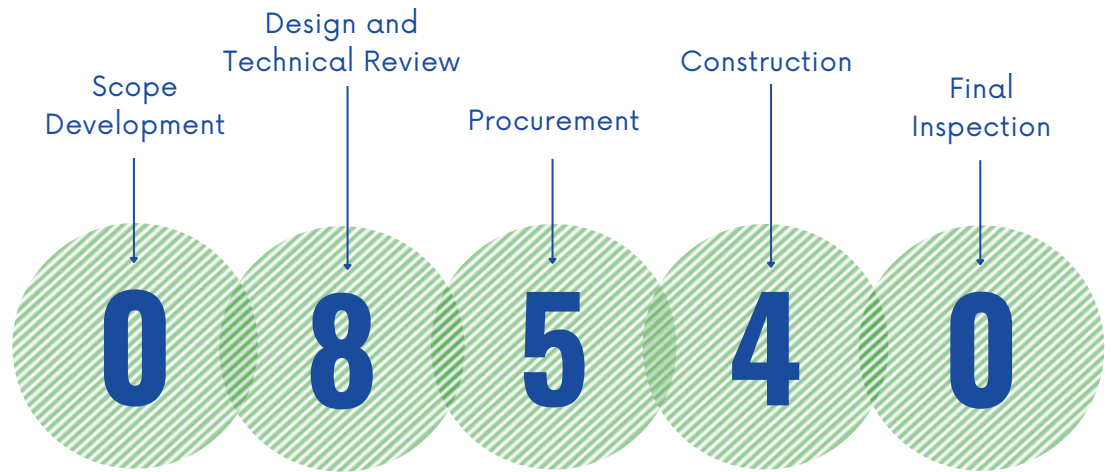
