Safety Stories & Experiences in Sandy Springs





Write on a sticky note about a recent roadway safety experience you had in Sandy Springs. Use the examples below for guidance.

"I have witnessed multiple collisions at the intersection of Mt Paran Road and Powers Ferry Road - at least five just this year. People either do not stop at the stop signs or do not know how to take turns at this four-way intersection..."

"People do not yield for pedestrians trying to cross this part of the intersection. They go from Johnson Ferry and quickly make the right without yielding or stopping. I have been almost hit a few times while crossing. Cars approaching will not slow down even if you are in the intersection..."

"It is very dangerous to sit in the left turn from Roswell Rd northbound to Dalrymple westbound. Traffic coming Roswell Rd southbound come up a hill and have to curve to the right to stay in their lane. Recently, my husband and I were nearly hit head on by a truck as we waited..."
