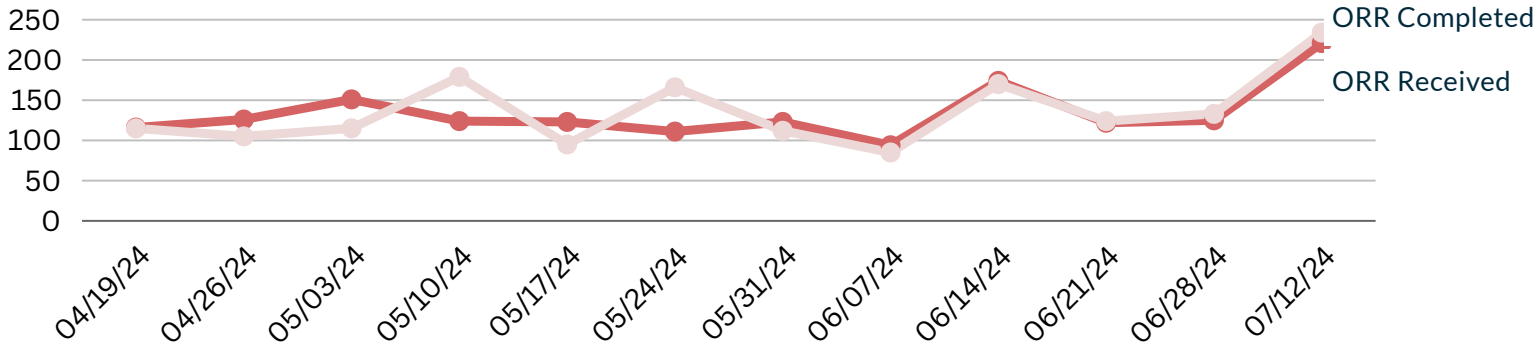

 - River Patrol had approximately 170 contacts over the weekend concerning personal flotation device and criminal trespassing violations. Verbal warnings were issued.

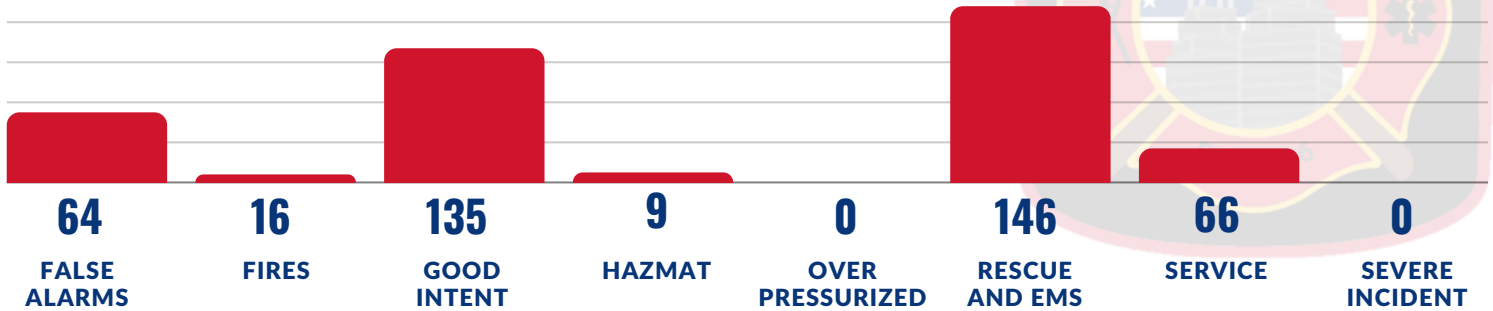
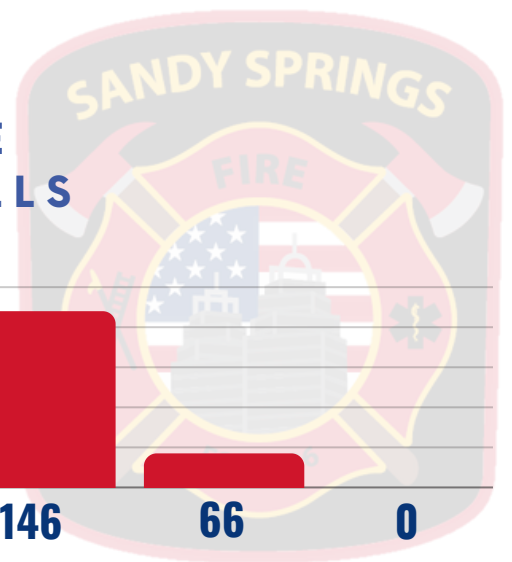
VOLUNTEER UNIT

The VIP and COP units reported 164 total volunteer hours, which include the hours they assisted with checking property during the Presidential debate and the Stars and Stripes Celebration. The COP hours composed of 20 patrol shifts patrolling a total of 953 miles. 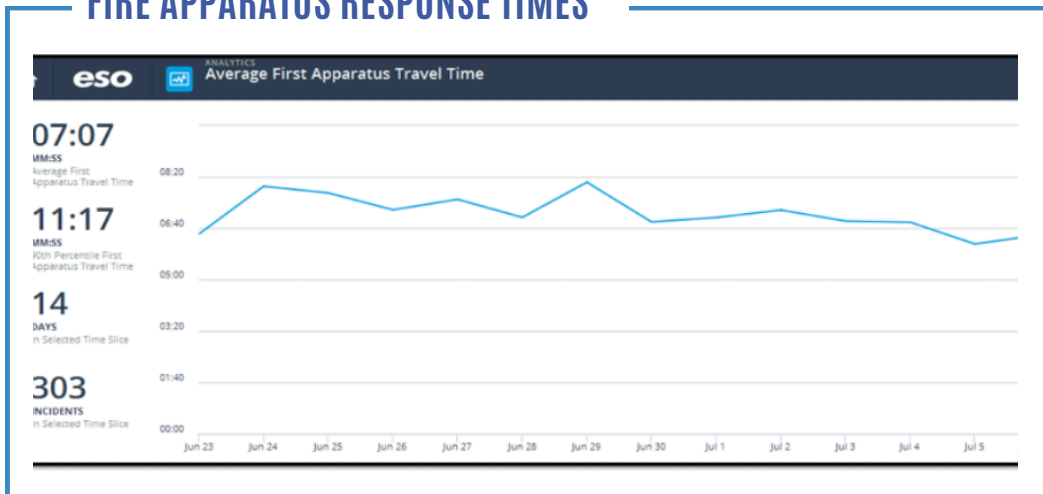

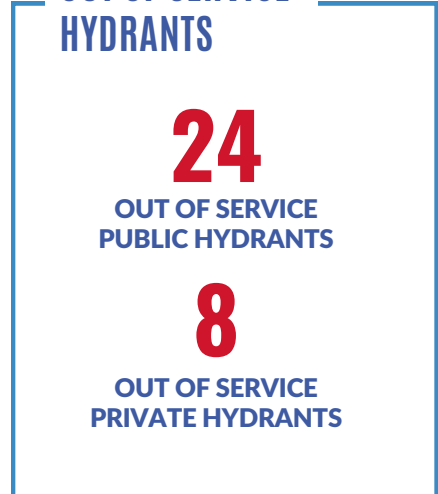

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

Fire units responded to the following reported incidents:

- An arcing fire in the 8600 block of Roberts Drive with no signs of smoke or fire from the exterior. Personnel entered the unit and observed a clicking noise in the electrical panel. Power to the unit was secured. Georgia Power was notified.
- A brush fire in the 400 block of Dalrymple Road. A landscaping company was made aware of the open burning ordinance. The brush fire was extinguished.

- A motor vehicle accident at I-285 westbound and GA-400 northbound on ramp. Personnel found an accident involving a tractor trailer and a box truck. All lanes of travel were temporarily closed. Personnel assisted AMR. AMR handled patient care and transport.

PROJECTS

DOG PARK IMPROVEMENTS

- The grading plan created to capture water outside and uphill from the dog park has been reviewed and returned for additional erosion controls. A vendor has been selected to bring water for fountains and washing station to the park.

MORGAN FALLS ATHLETIC COMPLEX IMPROVEMENTS

- A staggered closure of all fields is planned from July 1 through August 13 to renovate and level the grass turf. All but Field 2 and Field 5 are closed through July 23 for renovation. Fields 2 and 5 will close July 23 through August 13. Fields will be locked and signage posted.

SPRINGWAY TRAIL 2A

- As of July 10, fifty feet of boardwalk pier and framing installation remains. Completion of this project element is projected this week. Trail signage installation on the Georgia Power section is complete. Spur Trail concrete and retaining wall has been installed. Construction of a retaining wall across the trail from the Fulton lift station begins. The undeveloped length of trail from the Fulton access drive to the Spur-Orkin Lake spillway intersection will be the last area developed as part of the project.
- July 15 Week
 - The boardwalk contractor is beginning to demobilize operations. Boardwalk deck pan - for future concrete – begins installation, commencing more permanent steps for trail across the boardwalk. Work at the lift station retaining wall and signage installation on the Edgewater section continue.
- July 22 Week
 - Boardwalk demobilization continues. Boardwalk deck pan installation continues through early October. Trail signage installation continues.

MORGAN FALLS ATHLETIC COMPLEX PHASE III

- Hydrologic modeling is complete.
- Storm drainage design commences July 16 and will complete this month.

ABERNATHY GREENWAY SOUTH IMPROVEMENTS

- Construction documents are 50% complete.
- Existing and proposed hydrology and flood modeling is complete.
- Proposed stream channel design is in progress.

OLD RIVERSIDE PARK DEVELOPMENT

- Construction documents are 70% complete.
- Conceptual stormwater plans have been reviewed.

MAINTENANCE/LANDSCAPING

- The turf grass at Morgan Falls Athletic Complex needed renovation due to poor drainage and soil health and needed nutrients. The solution was to top-dress the turf to provide the benefits of a more functional and attractive sports fields. Some areas had multiple topdressing inches applied due to heavy undulations, thus increasing down time of certain fields. Renovation work on all 8 grass fields has concluded. These fields will remain closed through July 23.

MAINTENANCE/LANDSCAPING

- Staff repaired the Grace Park water fountain.
- Staff replaced five planks on one of the foot bridges at Lost Corner.
- Staff repaired urinal and replaced soap dispenser at Hammond Park men’s restroom.
- Staff performed monthly maintenance on turf field at Dunwoody Springs Elementary.
- Staff pressure washed picnic tables at Overlook Park and repaired fencing.
- Staff cleaned receptacles, dog stations, and signs at Greenway, Big Trees, Grace, and River Shore Meadows Parks.
- Staff repaired tennis and soccer netting at Ridgeview and Allen Road Parks.

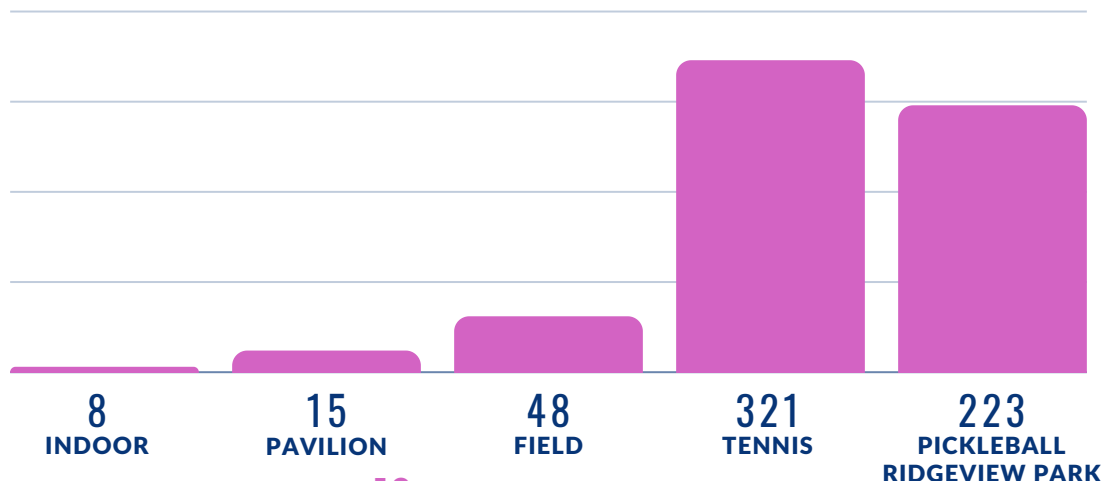
PAST PROGRAMMING

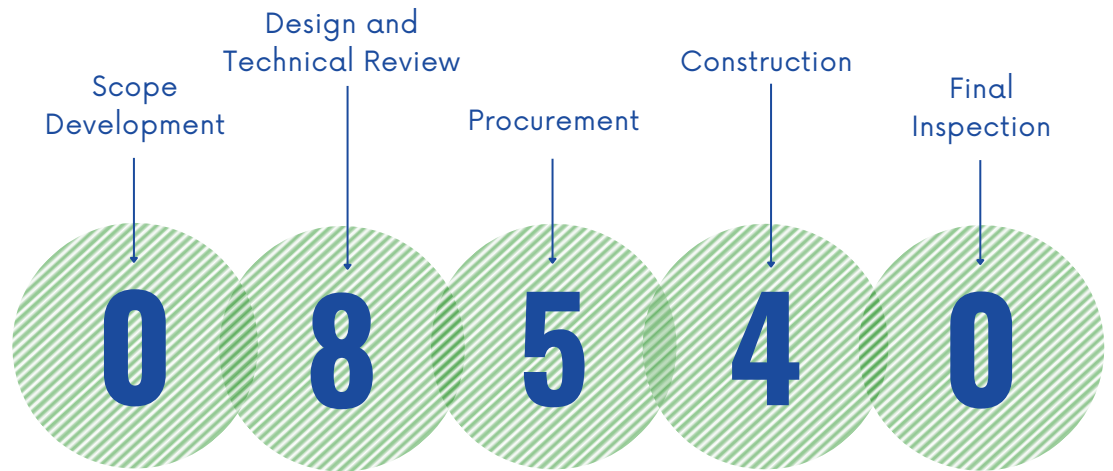
