





SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

Fire units responded to the following reported incidents:

- A gas leak in the 800 block of Hammond Drive. Personnel were notified of an odor of gas coming from the commercial kitchen and identified the stovetop pilots as the source. Ventilation was performed.

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





SPRINGWAY TRAIL 2A

- The natural turf at Morgan Falls Athletic Complex has responded well to the top-dressing renovation. Most bare spots have filled in and the overall health has exceeded all expectations. Mowing will begin on July 22nd and renovated fields will be open for play.
- Staff disposed of fallen branches at Ridgeview Park
- Staff installed four table umbrellas at Marsh Creek Raingarden Park.
- Staff repaired fencing and cleaned signage and receptacles at Windsor Meadows Park.
- Staff installed new signage board at North Abernathy Greenway Park.
