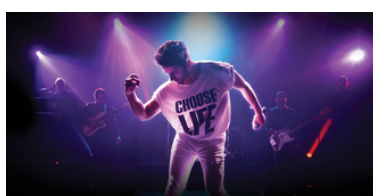

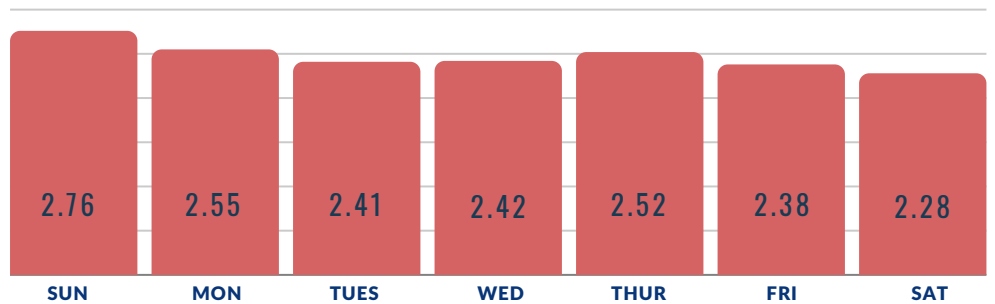

- Members of the Patrol Unit attended a neighborhood's HOA event.

SPECIAL OPERATIONS HIGHLIGHTS

- SCU conducted 21 traffic stops with 3 citations issued.
- SCU had 3 arrests of wanted individuals and recovered 1 stolen motor vehicle.
- Traffic Unit conducted 122 traffic stops with 170 citations issued.
- Traffic Unit had 1 arrest for driving while license suspended, 2 arrests for no insurance, and 1 arrest for DUI.
- Traffic Unit was called out to investigate a serious injury crash at the intersection of Glenridge Drive and Hammond Drive.
- K-9 Unit conducted 34 traffic stops with 35 citations issued.
- K-9 Unit had 1 arrest for domestic violence and seized 424 grams of marijuana/THC while assisting a business during a package sniff.
- Bike Unit conducted 11 traffic stops with 13 citations issued.
- Bike Unit conducted an urban camping detail to identify individuals sleeping in COSS parks and around City Springs overnight.

VOLUNTEER UNIT

The VIP and COP units reported 138 total volunteer hours. The COP hours composed of 8 patrol shifts patrolling a total of 421 miles. Additionally, the COP units conducted 18 house checks, 87 business checks, issued 9 handicap parking citations, and assisted officers on 4 traffic related incidents.

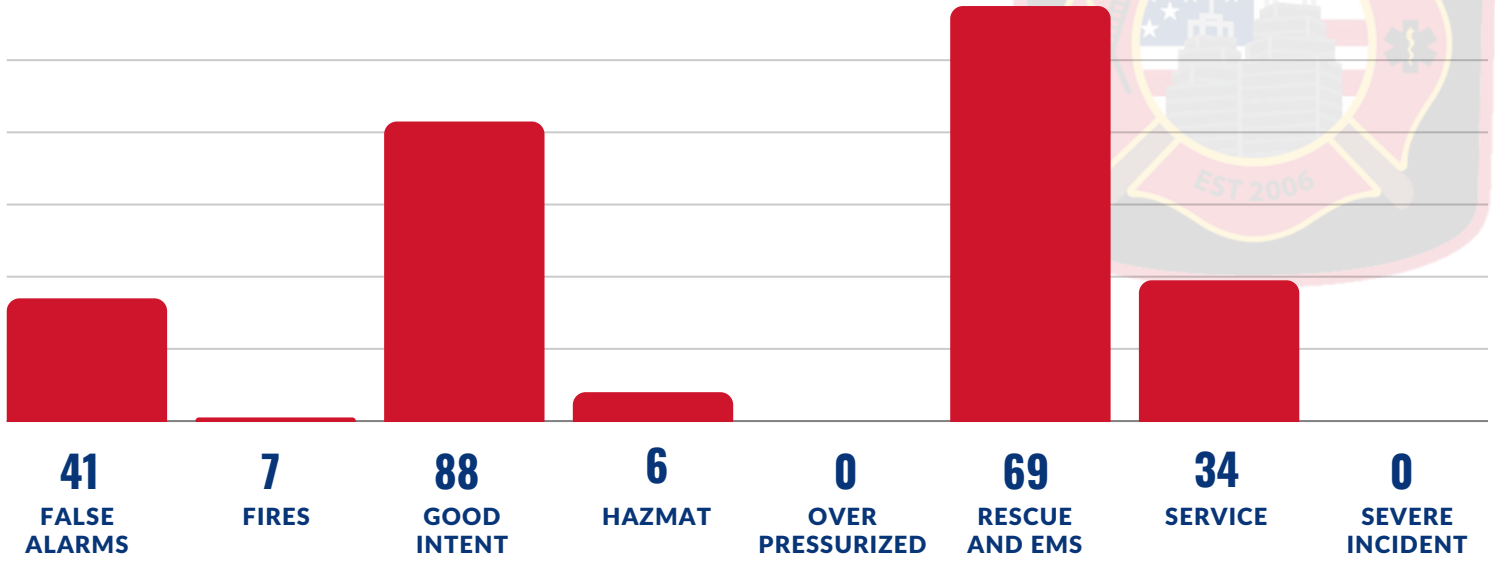

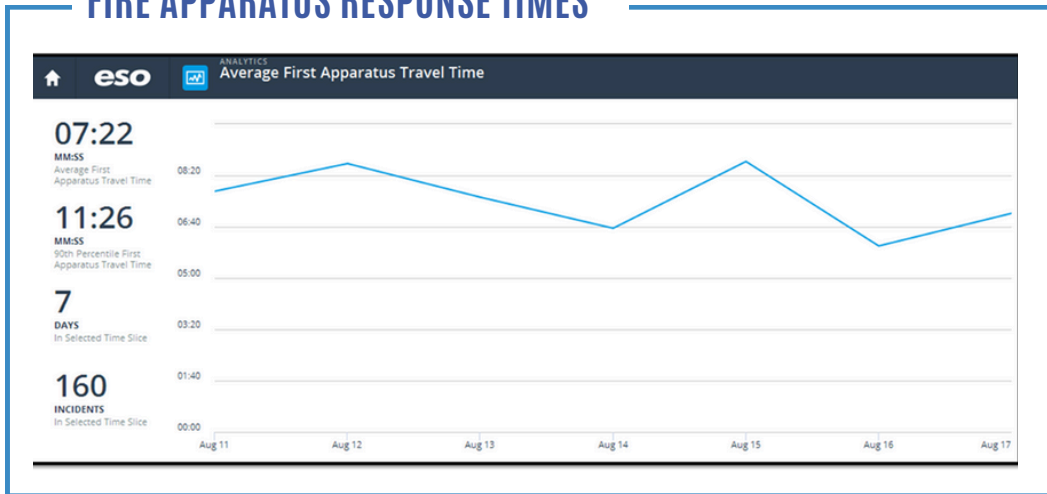

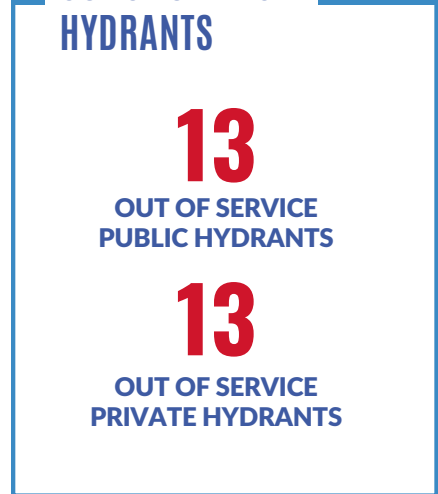

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

Fire units responded to the following reported incidents:

- A structure fire in the 3500 block of Treelodge Parkway. Personnel arrived at a split-level multi-family building with visible fire showing from the exterior. During the scene evaluation, one occupant was found still inside the structure and was assisted by fire personnel. The fire was extinguished, and overhaul operations were completed. The Fire Marshal's Office was notified for an investigation. The fire impacted 10 units, resulting in 15 displaced tenants. The Red Cross was contacted and assisted the displaced residents.
- An arcing fire in the 3600 block of Sandalwood Drive. Upon Arrival, personnel were notified of a bathroom fan fire that was out prior to arrival. Power to the unit was secured. No further hazards were found.

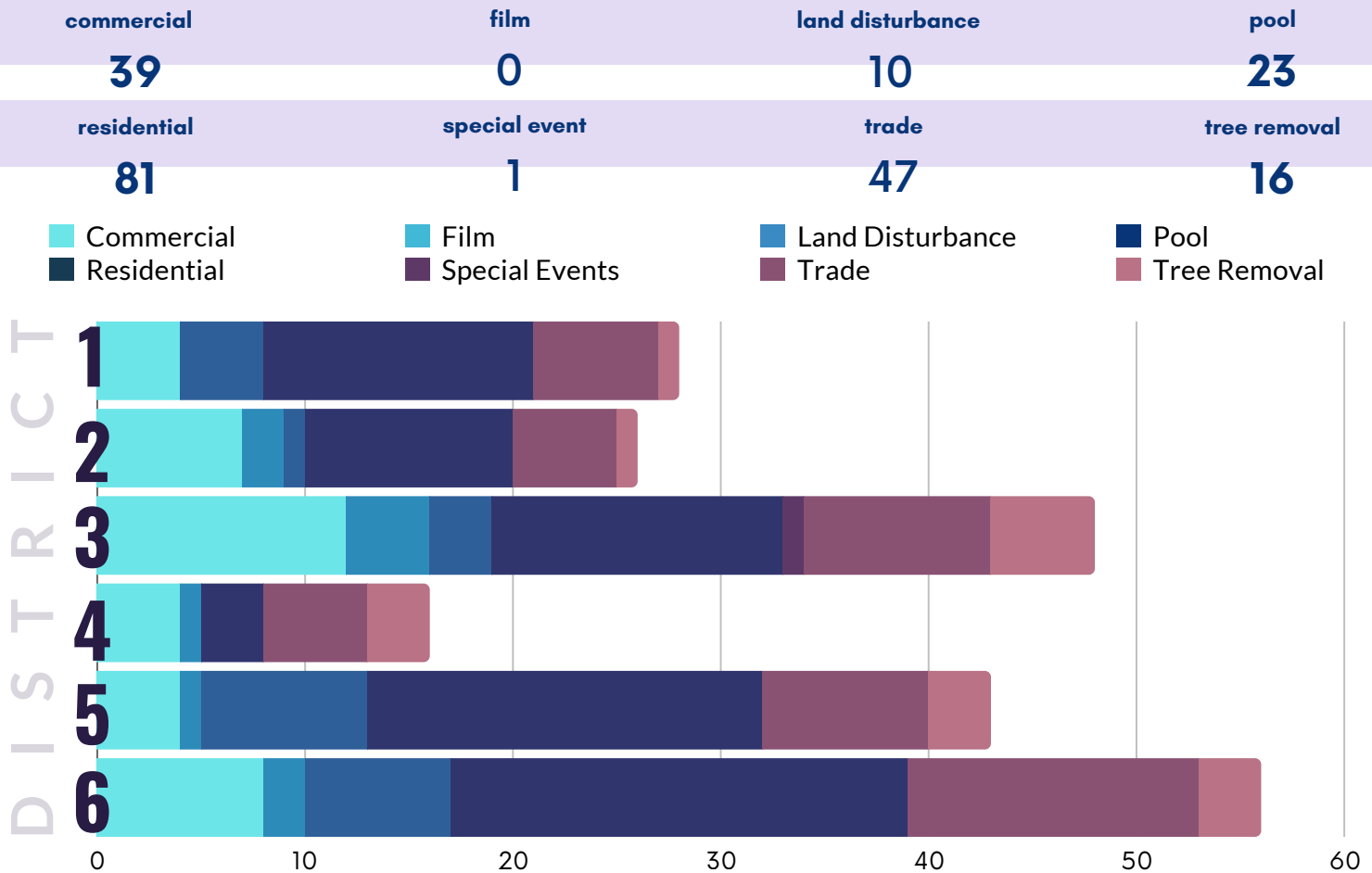
