

City Council Meeting Recap

Items below were discussed or voted on during the September 3, 2024 City Council Meeting. All items and their full presentations can be found on the Public Meeting website HERE.

Sidewalk Program Scoring Update

With Council consensus, Sidewalk Program scoring will now include a factor for density in prioritizing projects. Up to five points may be added to a project's relative score on a now 60-point overall evaluation scale. Candidate projects will be assessed using the updated criteria between now and the end of the calendar year.




Right of Way Acquisitions

Six right of way acquisitions for Project S2193, Hammond Drive Improvements were approved along with two other Permanent Easement Dedications at 2480 Spalding Drive and 5720 Riverside Drive.

Construction Contract Award for 4787 Riverview Road Stormwater Project

A construction contract award was approved in the amount of \$301,751.06 to Blount Construction Company for stormwater system repairs. Work is expected to take approximately five months to complete.

T2404 Morgan Falls Pedestrian Lighting



Morgan Falls Road Lighting Agreement

Council approved a Lighting Services
Agreement with Georgia Power Company
in the amount of \$703,750 to install
pedestrian lighting on Morgan Falls Road
from Roswell Road to the Overlook Park.
The work in this agreement is part of
Project T-2404, Morgan Falls Road
Lighting.

Design Guidelines Contract Awarded to Rhodeside & Harwell, Inc.

Council awarded a contract to Rhodeside & Harwell, Inc, for the creation of design guidelines for six areas of the City: Greater City Springs, Perimeter, North End, Powers Ferry, Crossroads, and Neighborhood Village. The Design Guidelines will establish desired architectural and urban design characteristics for the various mixed-use and commercial districts in these areas.

Purchase of a Pierce Enforcer Pumper

Council approved the purchase of one Pierce Enforcer Pumper for the Fire Department through Ten-8 Fire and Safety, LLC, not to exceed \$1,102,700.

KNOW WHAT TO DO!

If you're choking and no one's around — don't panic. Follow these first aid steps:

- 1. Call 911, even if you can't speak.
- 2. Give yourself abdominal thrusts right above your navel, with one hand over your fist.
- 3. Or, thrust your abdomen against a firm object. Avoid objects with sharp edges that can hurt you.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS - FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire units responded to the following reported incidents:

- A structure fire in the 5700 block of Winterthur Lane. Personnel observed a large smoke plume caused by the fire at a
 2-story single family dwelling on a basement. Further investigation confirmed a working structure fire. The fire was
 extinguished and personnel remained on scene to mitigate any hot spots. Fire Corps volunteers remained on scene
 providing personnel with rehab support.
- A 2-story single family home structure fire in the 1600 block of Huntingdon Trail. The residents met personnel in the yard and stated that their air conditioning condenser unit caught on fire after a lightning strike and was now extinguished. Personnel cooled the unit with water cans and pulled the exterior breaker. The residence was also checked for signs of a lightning strike. No smoke, fire, or heat signatures were found inside the home or in the attic. However, two rooms in the house's basement had their breakers tripped. The homeowner was advised to have an electrician check them for damage from the possible lightning strike prior to turning them back on.
- A structure fire in the 500 block of Northridge Crossing Drive. Personnel arrived on scene to a 2- story row townhouse with a working fire on the first floor. Upon entry into the residence, personnel observed that the bulk of the fire appeared to be in the back of the unit. Personnel extinguished the fire, performed a primary search of the first floor with an all clear, and began a primary search of the top floor. After personnel confirmed no individuals were in the structure, they completed ventilation and overhaul of the area.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Police Department responded to the following reported incidents:

- Traffic Unit conducted a traffic enforcement detail over the Labor Day weekend which led to 117 traffic stops with 134 citations issued.
- K-9 Unit organized the local 5th Annual Fallen K-9 Memorial Run/Ruck on the Cochran Shoals Trail along the Chattahoochee River.

What's happening in Sandy Springs

T2406 Safety Action Plan

Development of the city's Safety Action Plan continues with staff submitting a Safe Streets for All Supplemental Planning Grant request of \$1,168,000 to the U.S. Department of Transportation last week. Those funds would provide for additional studies, analysis and potentially demonstration efforts to further augment the plan. Current Projects Throughout the City

Field Services Repairs: This retaining wall at 6480 Roswell Road was damaged in a three-car accident earlier this year. A pedestrian scale streetlight was replaced and the wall and handrail were rebuilt to complete repairs.





Two-Week Lookahead



TS 108 Roswell Road at Dalrymple Road Intersection

Grading, curb and gutter, sidewalk, and signal installation are underway in preparation for roadway paving planned for the week of September 16.



TS111 Spalding Drive at Pitts Road Intersection

Installation of the final retaining wall will continue (5 of 6 walls complete), along with signal buildout and road widening.
Residential driveways will also continue reconstruction to tie into the new roadway.

Project Summary







S2177 Powers Ferry Sidewalk Connection

Construction is nearing completion with 325 feet of sidewalk constructed to complete a connection on Powers Ferry between Dupree Drive and New Northside Drive. This segment improves pedestrian access and safety to nearby schools, shopping, and transit stops. Improvements to existing handicapped ramps and MARTA bus stops will also be made within the project area. The project includes a midblock pedestrian crossing that will have a Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) signal when completed. Signal material delivery and installation is anticipated this month to complete the project.

The North Springs MARTA Corridor Study Pop-up Events











The North Springs MARTA Corridor Study is a strategic project to make the station a more walkable destination by improving multimodal safety and comfort on Peachtree Dunwoody Road; identifying a preferred route to extend the PATH 400 trail north to the station area; enhancing walking and biking access to the station; finding opportunities for placemaking at the station; and creating a concept for transit-oriented development on the North Springs MARTA Station property. Pop-up events at the North Springs MARTA Station were held on August 29th and August 31st, pictured to the left.


