
River Patrol

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

Fire units responded to the following reported incidents:

- A vehicle accident with injuries requiring extrication on I-285 Eastbound east of Roswell Rd. Personnel found one semi-responsive driver sitting in front of a vehicle with significant rear end damage. Personnel assessed, treated the patient on scene, and transferred care to AMR (American Medical Response) on arrival. Personnel found the other driver ambulatory on scene with no complaints or obvious injury.
- A gas leak in the 7000 block of Brandon Mill Road. Using a gas monitor, personnel detected a slight leak by the connection to the stove. Personnel shut down the outside gas supply meter and notified Atlanta Gas Light.
- Sounds of explosion in the 800 block of Davis Drive behind a residence. On scene the residents advised that the sounds were coming from the pool pump/heater area out back where a plumber had recently fixed a natural gas leak on the pool heater. The sounds continued after personnel arrived on scene and were in a rhythmic sort of interval resembling the sound of natural gas lighting off. The explosions ceased after personnel secured the gas.
- A carbon monoxide alarm in the 300 block of Kelson Drive. On scene personnel used a carbon monoxide (CO) monitor
 in the home and immediately had readings ranging from 19-28 parts per million (PPM). Personnel evacuated the
 occupants. Upon further investigation, personnel were unable to locate the source of the leak. Personnel secured the
 gas, ventilated the entire home and advised the homeowner to contact Atlanta Gas Light to determine the cause of
 the issue.
- A gas leak in the 5500 block of Glen Errol Road. Personnel arrived on scene to find a 0.5" service line had been cut in half and was free flowing. Personnel evacuated four residences closest to the incident and requested assistance from Atlanta Gas Light. Personnel remained on scene until Atlanta Gas Light arrived and mitigated the leak.

- Staff spread mulch near entrance to Morgan Falls Athletic Complex.

- Staff attended school open houses to present upcoming athletic and leisure events.
- The last week of Basketball camp was full with 20 campers at North Springs High School.

ONGOING/UPCOMING EVENTS

SUSTAINABLE GROWTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP S U S T A I N A B I L I T Y

- Bamboo & invasive removal at Morgan Falls Overlook Park along the Pavilion Trailhead was completed. Bamboo that escaped the overlook ridge had begun to take over the lower portion of the trail system. Bamboo rhizomes were dug up to limit regrowth. Pine straw was applied in affected areas to limit erosion.
- Overgrowth clearing at Morgan Falls Overlook Park completed. Young pine trees that were growing and threatening the retaining wall behind the bathrooms/playground/pavilion at Morgan Falls Overlook Park were removed mechanically.
- Another phase of invasive removal was completed at Lost Corner Forest Preserve. The work areas included the land surrounding the ADA trail, the greenhouse, and the native fruit tree orchard. All removals were done mechanically with no chemical intervention.
- Emergency removals of DDH (Dead/Dying/Hazardous) trees at Ridgeview Park. Five DDH trees were removed to ensure safety.
- The Eco-Stewards program resumed after a 1-month break in July. Eco-Stewards met at the Blue Pearl Vet Hospital with an education session on invasive species. The next volunteer event will be held on August 24th.
