#### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS - FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire units responded to the following reported incidents:

- A gas leak in the 6800 block of Roswell Road. Upon arrival, personnel observed food left on the gas stove with a burner knob left in the on position. Gas to the stove was secured, and ventilation was performed. No further hazards were found.
- A gas in the 500 block of Abernathy Road. Upon arrival personnel were advised of an odor of gas inside the residence.
   The source of the odor was identified near the HVAC furnace. Gas was secured to the entire structure, and ventilation was performed. Atlanta Gas Light was notified. Red Cross was contacted to provide temporary housing assistance. No further hazards were found.
- A vehicle fire at I-285 westbound and Northside Bridge. Upon arrival, personnel found multiple vehicles involved in an accident, including one entrapment and a fire in an electric vehicle (EV). The patient was extricated. The vehicle fire was extinguished using 1,100 gallons of water. No further hazards or battery off-gassing were identified. Traffic was affected for 1 hour and 40 minutes. AMR provided all patient care.
- A structure fire in the 1100 block of Hammond Drive. Upon arrival, personnel observed smoke in the kitchen area of a restaurant. The source was identified as an electrical outlet in the kitchen. Power to the affected area was secured. Personnel conducted a thorough check for potential fire extension. No further hazards were identified.

#### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

- The VIP and COP units reported 303 total volunteer hours, which included volunteer hours during the current Citizens Police Academy. The COP hours composed of 17 patrol shifts patrolling a total of 794 miles. Additionally, the COP units conducted 31 house checks, 138 business checks, issued 7 handicap parking citations, and assisted officers on 20 traffic related incidents.

# What's happening in Sandy Springs

#### **S2177 Powers Ferry Sidewalk Connection**

Construction is now complete for 325 feet of sidewalk making a connection on Powers Ferry between Dupree Drive and New Northside Drive. This sidewalk segment improves pedestrian access and safety to nearby schools, shopping and transit stops. Improvements to existing handicapped ramps and MARTA bus stops will also be made within the project area. Final crosswalk striping and roadway lighting is in place and the Rapid Flashing Beacon signal is now in service at the new midblock crossing.

## TS 108 Roswell Road at Dalrymple Road Intersection Improvements

Final roadway and signal work is now complete. The contractor is completing punchlist work with handrails pending installation to complete the project.

MARTA is scheduling the installation of a bus stop immediately south of the project in conjunction with both the project and adjacent redevelopment.

## Two-Week Lookahead


#### TS 191 Roswell Road/Johnson Ferry/ Mt. Vernon Highway Intersection Improvements

Major utility relocations are ongoing with approximately 75% of required gas main relocations now complete. Temporary signal installations are underway on the newly named Spruill Lane. Opening of the new roadway portion of the project to traffic is planned for early to mid-December.

## S2168 Hilderbrand Sidewalk

A construction contract was recently awarded with work expected to begin on site in January. The project will include constructing a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of Hilderbrand Drive along the frontage of the Georgia Power Substation and will connect to the existing multiuse path along the Georgia Power Substation from Mount Vernon Highway. It will also include a 6-foot sidewalk with 2-foot paver band on the south side of Hilderbrand Drive from 215 Hilderbrand Drive where no sidewalk is currently in place. Pedestrian lights are being added on both sides of the street along the new project.

## City Council Meeting Recap

Items below were discussed or voted on during the November 19, 2024 City Council Work Work Session or Regular Meeting. All items and full presentations can be found on the Public Meeting website HERE.

#### **Right of Way Dedication**

A dedication of permanent easement at 6204 Riverside Drive was accepted by Mayor and Council on the Consent Agenda.

#### **Right of Way Donations**

Donations of right of way and easements in the interest of constructing sidewalks were accepted by Mayor and Council on the Consent Agenda. Addresses were 1144 Evergreen Drive, 575 Mt. Paran Road and 115 Mt. Paran Road.

#### **Right of Way Purchase**

A purchase of permanent drainage easement and temporary construction easement to construct Project S2193, Hammond Drive Improvements was accepted by Mayor and Council on the Consent Agenda.

#### Award of On-Call Engineering Design Services

**The Mayor and Council approved the award of Engineering On-Call Services Contracts to seven design and consulting firms.** The On-Call Services will be used to provide design support for Public Works Capital Improvement Program projects.

#### **Award of Materials Testing Services Contract**

The Mayor and Council approved the award of a Materials Testing Services Contract to NOVA Engineering and Environmental in support of the PATH 400 Multiuse Trail Extension Project.

#### **Dedication of Right of Way to Construct a City Street**

The Mayor and Council approved the dedication of the new City street being constructed by Project TS-191. The new street is named Spruill Lane and connects Mt. Vernon Highway and Johnson Ferry Road between Roswell Road and Glenridge Drive.

#### Rezoning RZ24-0002

The Mayor and City Council approved a Zoning Map Amendment (Rezoning) of property owned by Ashton Woods, Aria at 6511 Beacon Drive, to remove the condition of zoning requiring the dedication of open space to the City. This removes a condition of zoning from a previous case from April of 2015 (RZ2015-01168) that required the dedication of the land to the City and rezones the property from Conservation (CON-) to Conservation (CON-).

## Current Projects Throughout the City

The Sandy Springs Racquet Center had its crumbling cross tie retaining wall replaced with an updated belgard block wall. It is an engineered retaining wall block system used by Department of Transportation and has a proven durability, resistance to corrosion, and robust tensile strength. The new wall provides an up-to-date, modern look with clean lines.



## Springway Trail

Concrete over the remaining section of trail from the Fulton County lift station to the western end of the Edgewater Apartments spur trail is complete as well as the Orkin Lake boardwalk. Railing work is in progress on the spur trail and at the pedestrian bridge behind Edgewater **Apartments** the clubhouse. Railing on the south side of the boardwalk starts this week. Signage installation on the trail resumes.






