TSPLOST 2026 Proposed Projects Public Open House

Welcome to the TSPLOST 2026 Public Open House.

All cities must present the lists of potential projects for TSPLOST to Fulton County by June. If authorized, residents will vote whether to approve the referendum on November 3, 2026. Originally approved by voters in November 2016 and renewed by voters in November 2021, the referendum would not increase the existing sales tax, but it would extend the TSPLOST 0.75% (3/4 of a cent) sales tax that is used to build bridges, alleviate congestion, fund safety projects, pedestrian and bike improvements, and roadway projects.
